

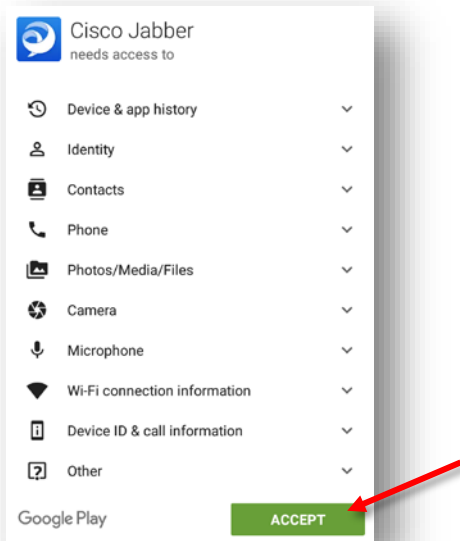
Installing Cisco Jabber on Your Android Device

In this tutorial, we will walk through installing Cisco Jabber on your Android mobile device.

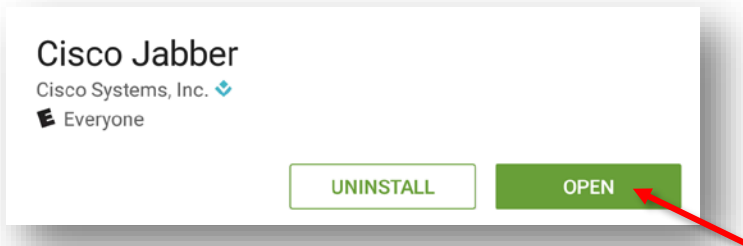
1. From your Android device, open Google Play and search for “**Cisco Jabber.**” You will be able to identify the correct application easily by look for the Jabber Symbol in your search results.



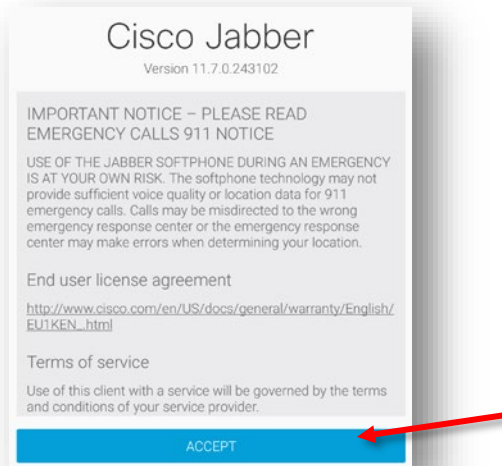
2. Install the application, accepting default permissions.



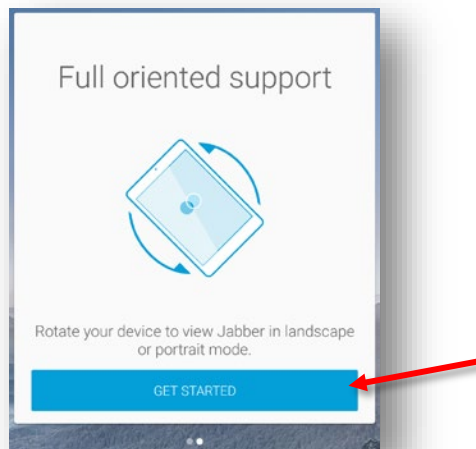
3. Tap “**Open**” once your installation has completed.



4. **“Accept”** the End User License Agreement.



5. Swipe right to the second page of the overview and tap **“Get Started.”**



6. Enter your NJIT email address and tap **“Continue.”**



7. Then, enter your password and tap “Sign In.”
