

Turning Your Media into a Video Quiz

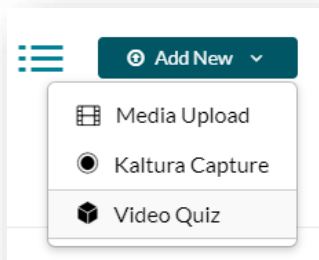
Kaltura's **Video Quiz** feature will help you create engaging, interactive quizzes for your students by embedding multiple questions in your lecture recording or other media.

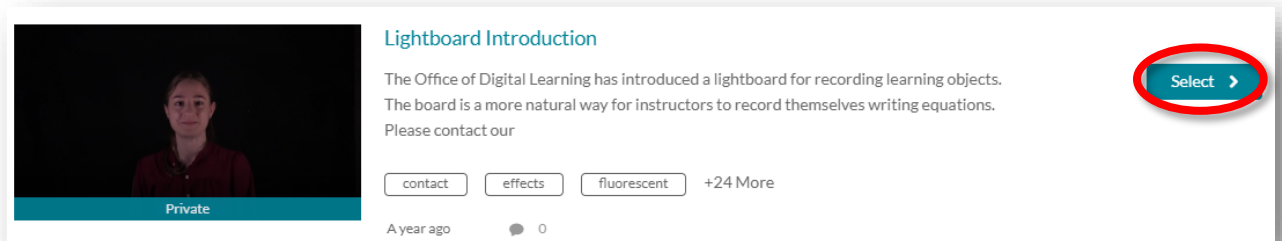

Getting Started

1. Select **"Video Quiz"** from the **"Add New"** menu in the **"My Media"** page in Canvas or Moodle.

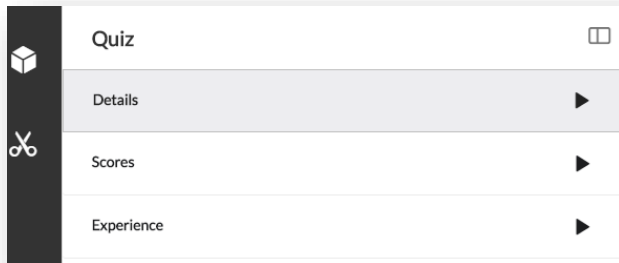


2. Choose the media that you would like to turn into a video quiz and click the **"Select"** button.

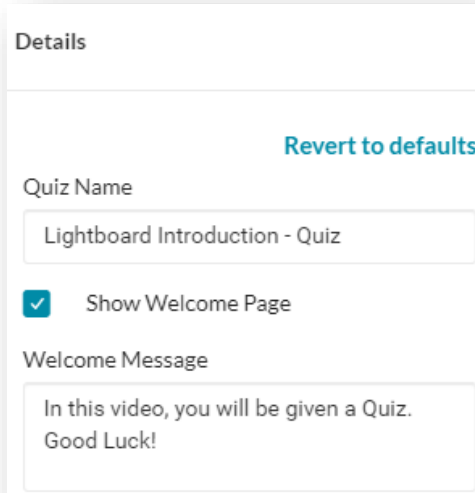


Adjusting Quiz Settings

1. While creating or editing your quiz, you can adjust the **Details**, **Scores**, and **Experience**.



1. Click on the **Details** dropdown menu to edit the **Quiz Name**, customize your **Welcome Message**, and choose whether or not you would like to display **Instructions**.



2. Click on the **Scores** dropdown to edit the score settings. By default, viewers will be able to see their quiz score, along with correct and incorrect answers, after submitting. If you would prefer to adjust these settings:
 - Click **“Do Not Show Scores”** to remove the “Show Scores” setting.
 - Untick **“Include Answers”** checkbox to remove this setting.

Upon Submission:

Do Not Show Scores
A 'Thank You' message will display after submitting the quiz.

Show Scores
Your viewers will see the quiz score page after the quiz is submitted.

Include Answers
Your viewers will be able to see correct/incorrect answers

3. Click on the **Experience** dropdown to edit experience settings. By default, the viewers will be allowed to change their answers before submitting the quiz. By default, they will also be allowed to skip questions. You can click these options to adjust the settings.

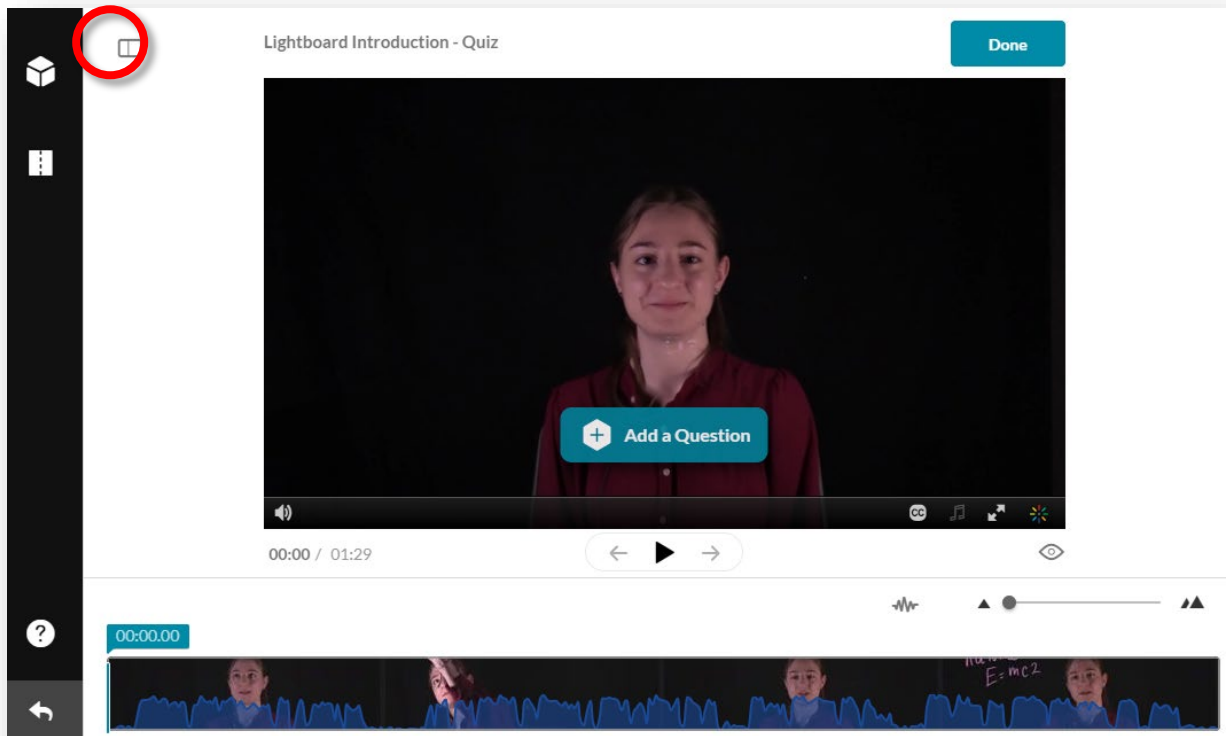
Allow Answers Change
Allow viewers to change their answers before submitting the quiz.

Allow Skip
Users will be presented with the 'skip for now' button.

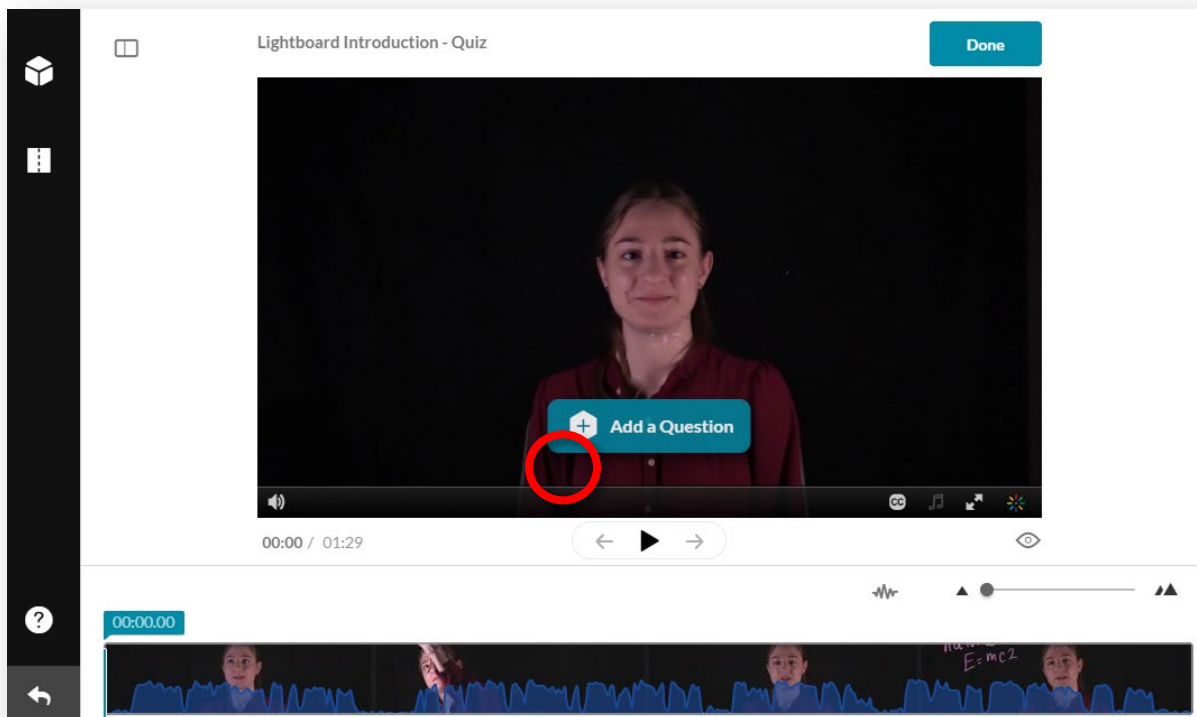
Do not Allow Skip
Users must submit an answer before proceeding forward.

Adding Questions to Your Video Quiz

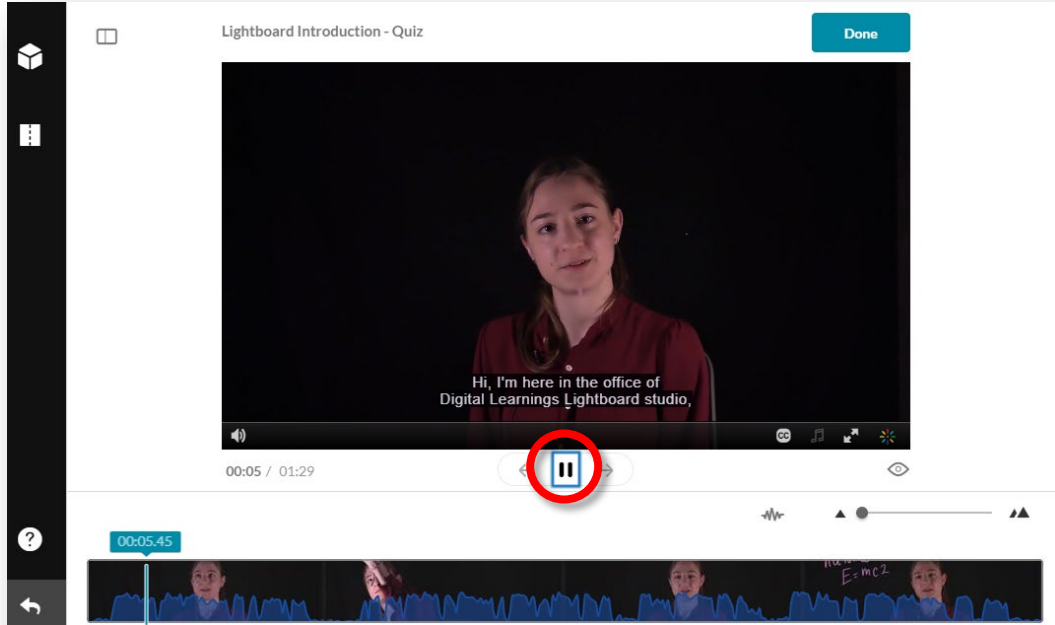
For a better view of the screen, click on the upper left tab to minimize quiz settings.



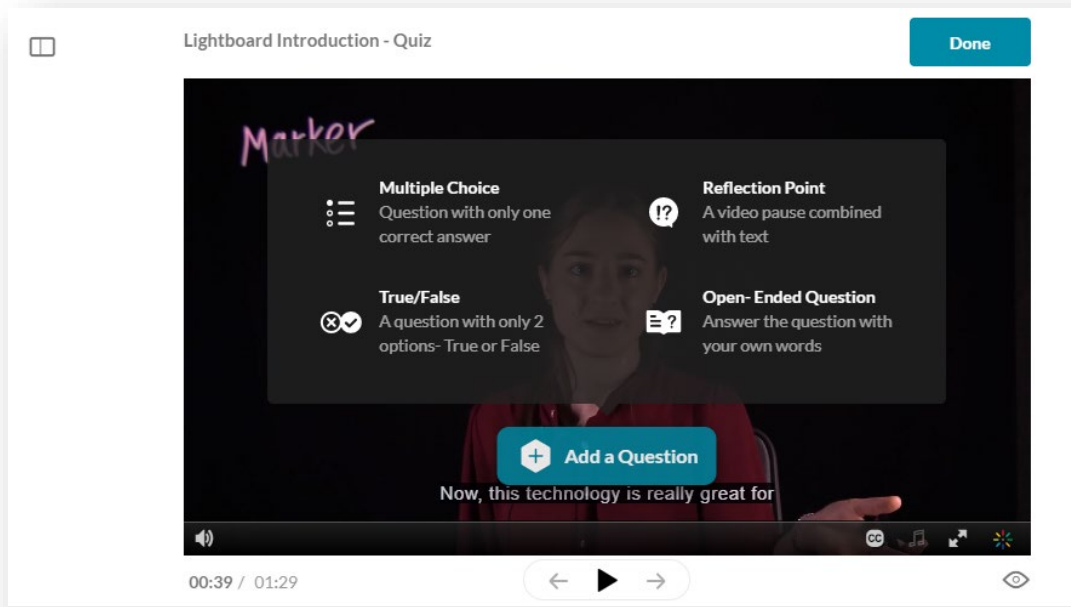
1. Start playing the video.



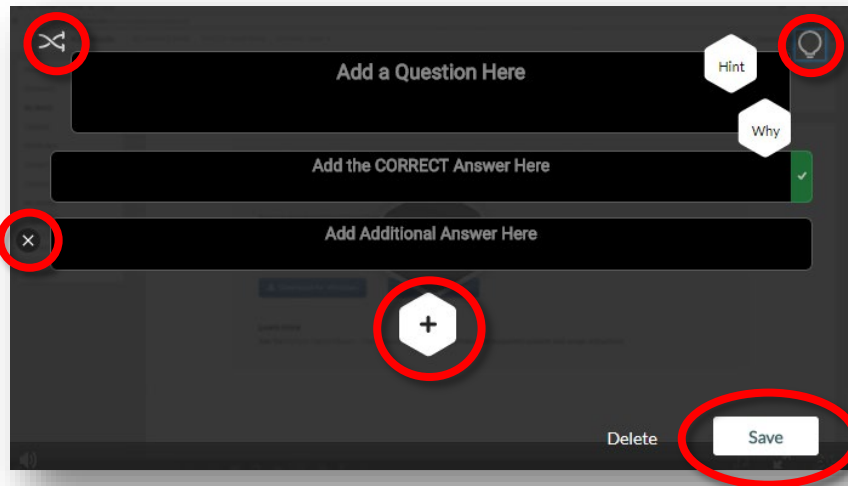
2. Pause where you want to add a question.



3. Click “Add a Question” to add a question and related answers. Then, select the question type you would like to use.



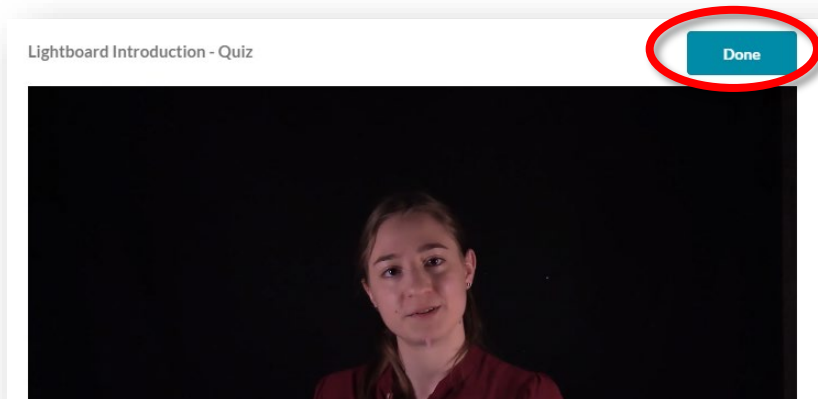
4. Enter your question and then add, delete, and shuffle your answers. You can also include a “Correct Answer Rationale or provide students with a Question Hint Once you are done, click “Save.”



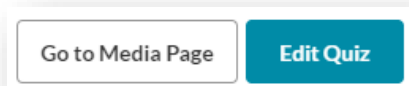
5. The question will appear along your video's timeline. You can click on the icon to edit your question.



6. Once you've added all of your questions and are satisfied with your quiz, click "Done."



7. Then, you can click "Go to Media Page" or "Edit Quiz."
