

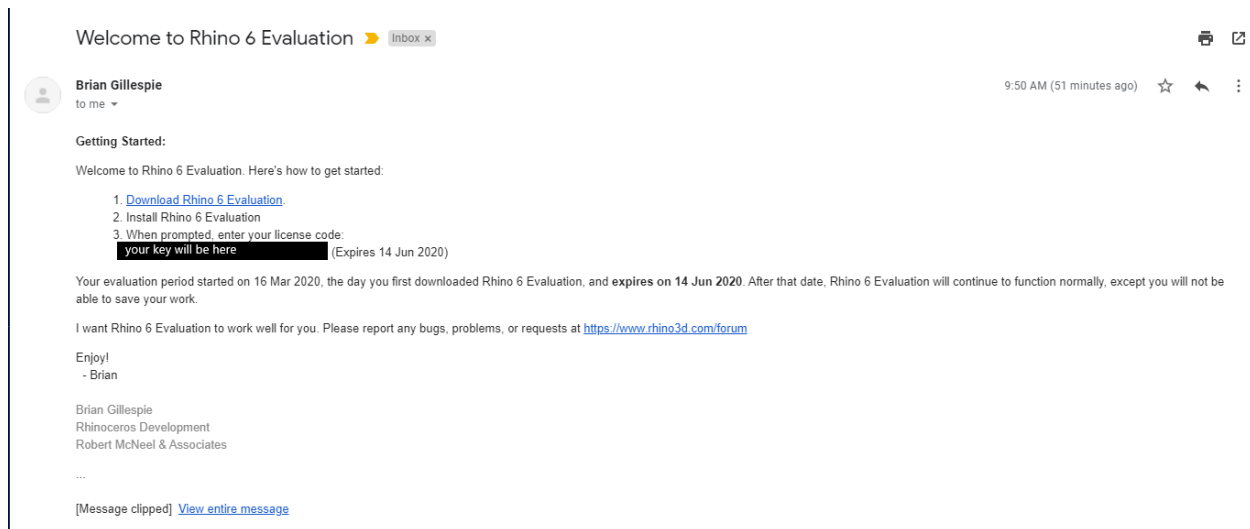
Using Rhino while at home

The Rhino Zoo (license server) is not available at home or through the VPN.

Each student should request a trial license of Rhino 6 here. (Please use a real email address as you will need it in the next steps)

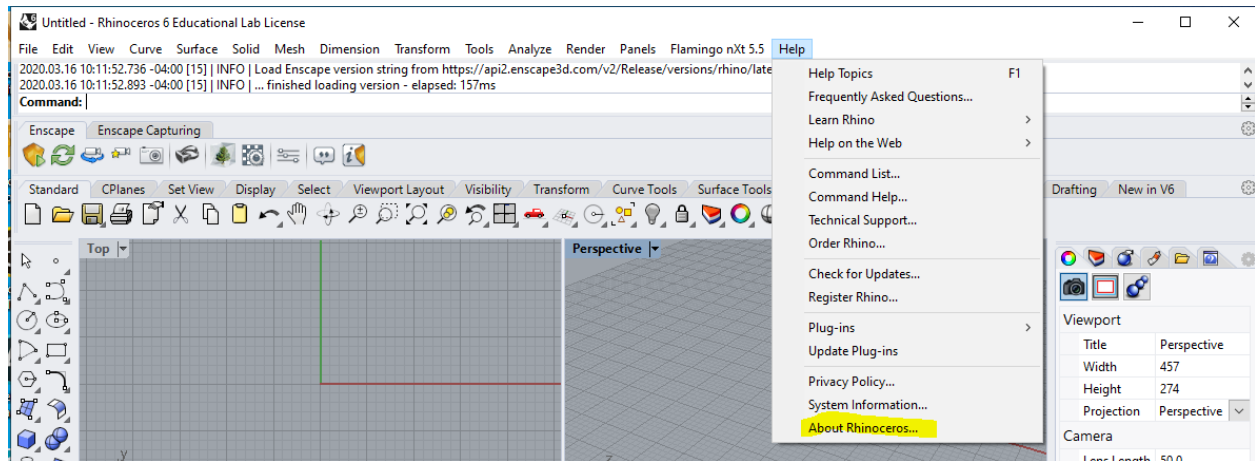
After you have requested the evaluation using the above link you will receive an email from Rhino (McNeel) that looks like this:



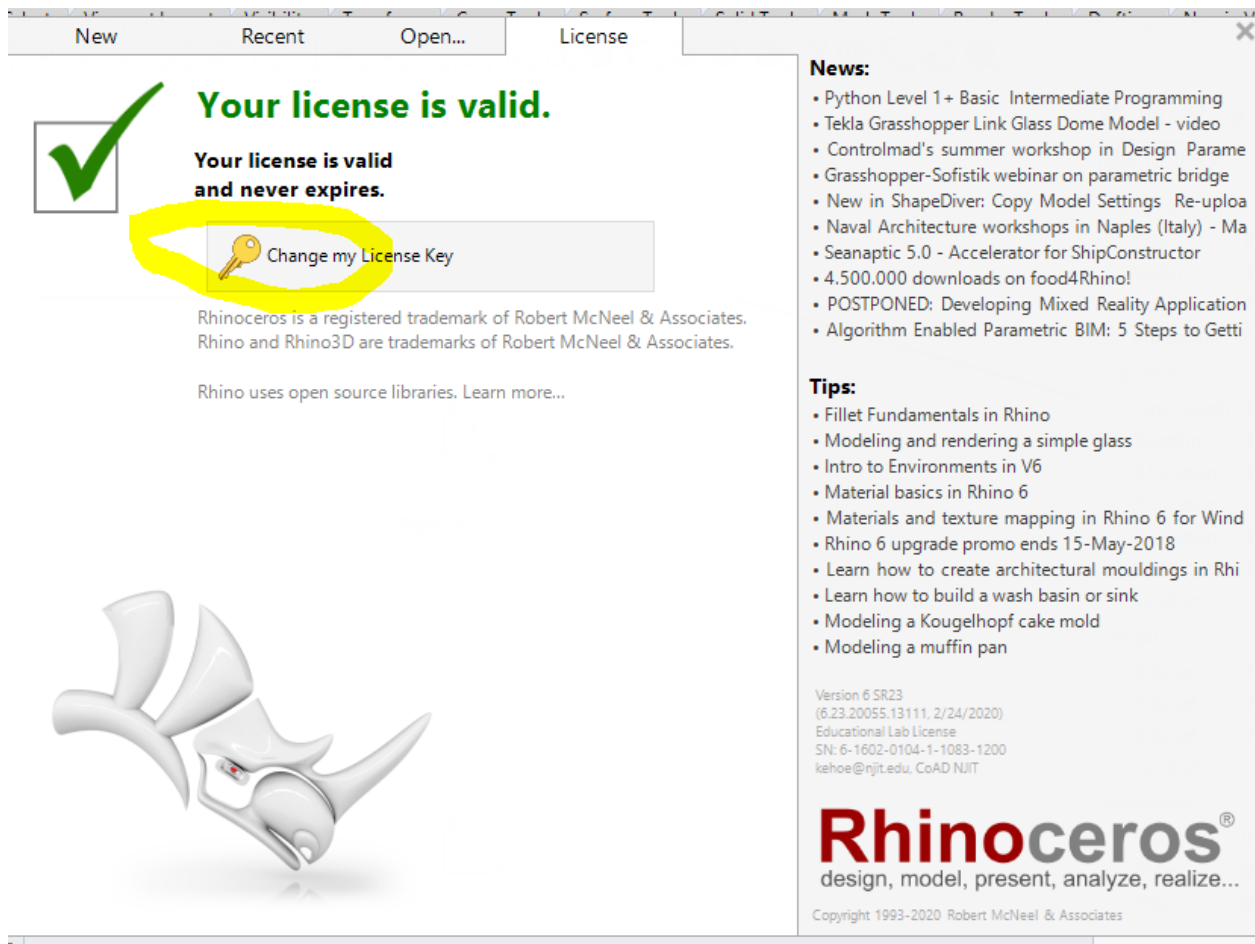
If you already have Rhino installed you DO NOT NEED TO REINSTALL OR DOWNLOAD from the link provided. The Key in this email is the important piece.

To change your license inside Rhino you will need to open the license manager. This may already be open if you have tried to connect to the NJIT license server, if so skip to step 3. If not, follow all steps below.

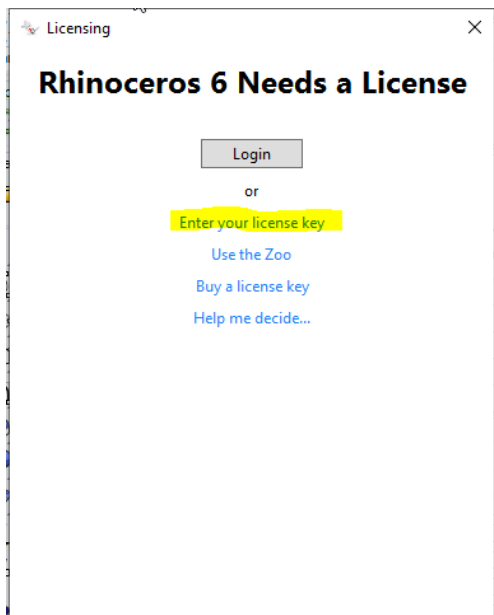
1. Access the About Rhino page



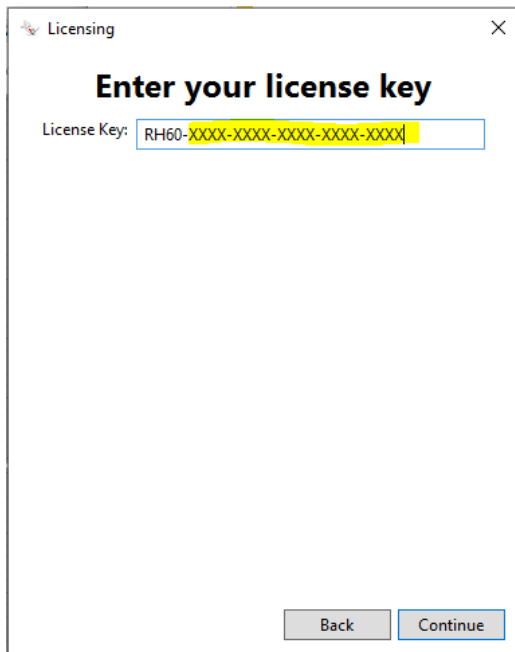
2. Click "Change my License Key"



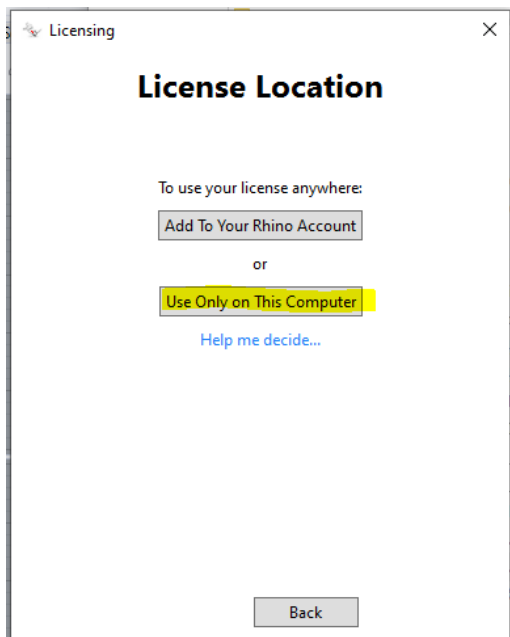
3. Choose "Enter your license key"



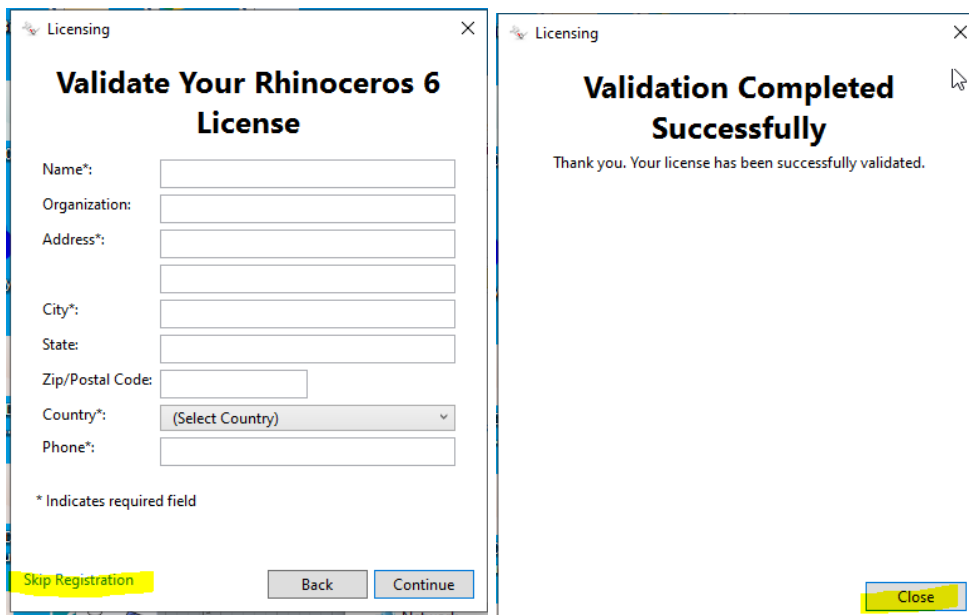
4. Enter the key provided to you in your email



5. Choose to use only on this computer



6. You may choose to "skip registration" or Fill it out if you like



Rhino should now be working with your 90 day trial.

When you return to campus you will want to visit the license manager again and set it back to "use the zoo, auto detect"
